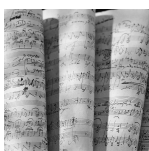

## Guitar - Classical, Electric & Acoustic Class Notes



Classes 47, 48, 50, 53	One piece or two contrasting pieces should be played.
Classes 49 & 51	All players must be within the age limits. One piece or two contrasting pieces should be played.
Class 52a	Intended to encourage adult restarters or beginners to enter. Any standard up to Associated Board Grade 5 (or equivalent).
Class 52b	Designed for adults playing to a standard of Associated Board Grade 5 to 7.
Class 54	All ages. Entrants must play one substantial item, which may be a sonata movement, or a suite and should be a test of musicianship and technique. The winner of this class ONLY is eligible to enter the Finalists' Competition on the recommendation of the Adjudicator.
Class 55	This section is open to all ages and standards. Entrants can play one piece or two contrasting pieces of their choice (including accompanying a vocalist).
Class 56	This NEW CLASS is non-competitive and allows participants of any age, standard or instrument/voice to perform in front of an audience and receive an informal assessment if required.

### Special Prizes:

A Festival Prize of £25 will be awarded to the most promising guitarist 14 years & under.

A Festival prize of £25 will be awarded to the most promising guitarist 15 years & over.
